

SOLIDARITY with Cal strike Rally Today

THE STRIKE AT BERKELEY GOES ON. After the first day of strike, 10,000 Cal students met in the rain in Sproul Plaza and almost unanimously voted to continue.

STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY at Stanford fully support the strike. The incidents leading up to the strike show that the Administration allow outside military agencies to exploit the university community, but denies to anti-war organizations of students the right to operate in the same manner within their own university.

The swift and purposeful response of the students through the sit-in and strike indicate that the insurgency at Berkeley has grown and matured greatly since the FSM. The desperate response of the Administration in their response to police violence show that they, on the other hand, have learned nothing. The strike is being carried out by a central Strike Committee, and by the Student Senate, Local 1570 American Federation of Teachers, the Council of Campus Organizations, the Graduate Coordinating Committee, and individual professors.

Today at noon in White Plaza SDS is holding a solidarity rally. Norman Katz of the Strike Committee will be here to tell us the Berkeley scene. Local speakers will be Janet Howell of OFF, LASSU rep John Shippey, presidential assistant Tim Haight, and Robert Hass of the Experiment. John Saari of SDS will be chairman.

In case of rain, the rally will be inside TMU large lounge.
