

COPY OF LETTER SENT TO PRESIDENT PITZER AND THE STANFORD TRUSTEES

TO: President Pitzer and the Trustees of Stanford University

April 11, 1969

Dear President Pitzer and the Stanford Trustees:

The people of the SRI Coalition involved in the sit-in at the AML voted a number of actions we feel must be taken by the Trustees of Stanford University. These actions are:

1. On Monday, April 14, 1969, the Trustees hold an open decision-making meeting (in Memorial Auditorium or some other large facility on campus) to consider and take action on the following Coalition demands:
 - a. No classification of Research at Stanford and SRI
 - b. No Vietnam War research or other war related research at Stanford and SRI
 - c. No Chemical, Biological or Radiological Warfare Research at Stanford and SRI
 - d. No Counter-Insurgency Research at Stanford or SRI

2. On Thursday, April 17, 1969, the Trustees hold an open decision-making meeting (in Memorial Auditorium or some other large facility on campus) to consider and act upon the future of SRI and its relationship to Stanford University.

The two separate meetings will allow consideration of the many issues to be discussed on Monday and will allow also for consideration by the Trustees of the SRI Committee report on SRI to be released on Tuesday.

Enclosed also is a copy of the letter sent to Leonard Schiff, President of the Academic Senate, concerning the decisions reached today by the Coalition regarding the Academic Senate and our demands.
