WHEREAS, the students of Stanford University have taken the initiative in alerting the American people to the dangers of warfare research by the university/governmental coalition and

WHEREAS, educational institutional involvement in war-related research does often coerce institutional members to pursue goals of the military-industrial complex to which they are personally and morally opposed, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the California Democratic Council support the goals of the Stanford University April 3rd Movement, which calls for an end in our Universities to all research and development designated for categorized as:

- 1. Defense classified
- 2. Chemical, Biological, and Radiological Warfare
- 3. Counterinsurgency
- 4. Relating to pursuit of the goals of a military resolution of the Vietnam War; AND BE IT

RESOLVED, that the California Democratic Council commend the President of Stanford University for his conduct thus far in this confrontation; AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that this support be communicated to the President and each Trustee of Stanford University.

This resolution was submitted by HERB BOROCK, a member of the April Third Movement and a student in the doctoral program at the Stanford Graduate School of Business.
