

## Tentative Guide for Affinity Groups

- I. Main coordinator.
  - A. He will keep in touch with the affinity group leaders.
  - B. People who want to join groups who are not at this meeting can do so through him.
- II. Reason for groups.
  - A. Decentralization of movement.
  - B. All coordinating committee meetings have been open, but to make them more representative of the whole movement each affinity group should be represented.
  - C. Facilitate flow of information.
  - D. Improve opportunity for individual discussion.
  - E. Provide for greater participation in decision making.
- III. Structure- the groups should be as heterogeneous as possible.
  - A. Groups should include people with varying political viewpoints.
  - B. Groups should include people of varying experience in the movement.
- IV. Function.
  - A. Political discussion and education.
  - B. Attempt to send a representative to coordinating committee meetings.
  - C. Inform those who cannot attend meetings on campus.
