Swelling to nearly 700, Stanford students occupying the Applied Electronics Laboratory (AEL) voted at 1:30 p.m. to continue their sit-in until a 7:30 meeting at which time the feelings of the Faculty Academic Senate will be known.

The Senate is meeting this afternoon and will discuss both the students' goals and tactics. They have also been requested by students to supplant Friday's classes with talks on the issues of University involvement in classified and military research.

Decision to stop or continue the occupation of the building was postponed until after the faculty's meeting because students felt that a judgment at an earlier time would be premature. The faculty's opinions will be important considerations in the evening meeting.

In the meantime they are trying to discover the Community's response to their actions and are spending the afternoon in small discussion groups in AEL or in informal talks in the dorms.
