800 MANBERS OF THE APRIL 3RD MOVEMENT WOTEDTODAYTO DISRUPT THE ACTIVITES OF THE HANOVER STREET FACILITIESOF STANFORD RESEARCH INSTITUE(SRI), STARTING FRIDAY MORNING. THEY HANOVER FATILITIESOF SRI ARE ENGAGED ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY IN COUNTER-INSURGENCY RESEARCH.

For over six weeks, the A3M has demanded that counter-insurgency research be terminated both at SRi and on the Stafford campus. They will try on Friday to present that research from being done.

The April 3rd Hovement has invited all residents of the Bay Area to join with them in their actions.

The vote of the Movement came the day after the Stanford Board of Irusters' decision to sell SRI. The A3M felt the trustees' curtailment of chemical andbiological warfare research was not an acceptable attempt to eliminate war-related research at SRI. The trustees did not trry to limit classified, counterinsurgency, or other military research currently being done.
