



For their "peaceful disruptions", five members of the off-ROTC movement face contempt hearings Thursday morning at 9:30 in the North County Court House off California Avenue. Grass Roots urges you to attend the trial in the morning, and then to join us in a train-ride to San Francisco where we will smash a model of the Palo Alto Square Project at the Dillingham Corporation offices.

The Stanford Five are fighting ROTC, whose function is the training of officers to protect American corporate interests around the world. Vietnamese who resist corporate and military control of their country face death at the hands of ROTC officers and their men. Here at home those who fight the giant corporations and ROTC face riot police and the courts, thus far. Dillingham is expanding into Southeast Asia and onto Stanford lands. Grass Roots believes this expansion ignores the needs of people at home and abroad. We join with those who are resisting American penetration of the Third World by resisting the expansion of Dillingham and its multi-national cohorts in the Mid-Peninsula.

Area residents and students have protested the construction of Palo Alto Square. We have enjoined the University and Dillingham from building this project. Both have ignored our protest. If and when we try to enforce our injunction, we shall be met by theirs. As we have learned in the past, effective action opens us to court action and arrests.

Therefore, Grass Roots asks you to stand with the Stanford Five in court. We will then leave the court at 11:30 and take the 11:50 SP to San Francisco, demonstrate, and return on the 1:50. Join us in a short journey to the nerve center of West Coast imperialism on the railroad that made Leland Stanford rich. (Although privately owned, the SP has received the provisional approval of the People's Committee on Ecologically Sounder Transit.) Scholarships available for those who can't afford train fare.
