

Stanford SDS presents RED FLAG TOURS

Tomorrow, as we protest the war by staying out of class, or working in the communities, we will be attempting to influence far-away powers in Washington. Very few members to the Stanford community realize the importance that Stanford, and corporations located on Stanford lands, have in this country's ability to continue the War.

To satisfy the long-felt need for information about what actually goes on in the Stanford Industrial Park--that massive conglomeration of factories and laboratories to the South of campus--Stanford SDS has organized the Red Flag tour service. We will walk through the Industrial Park and learn from one of Red Flag's experience guides.

On October 15 there are two tours planned.

Tour 1: We will meet at the Red Flag by the Tresidder parking lot at 9:45 am. We will drive to Hanover and California Streets, where the tour will begin at 10:00 am.

Tour 2: We will meet at the Red Flag by the Tresidder parking lot at 1:45 pm. We will drive to Hanover and California Streets, where the tour will begin at 2:00 pm. An advanced excursion may be planned, with sufficient demand, for graduates of tour 1. The advanced excursion would meet with tour 2, but split off to go to the Stanford Research Institute facility in Menlo Park.

Tour 3: There is no tour three, but you can help SDS leaflet factories in the afternoon, at about 4:00 pm.
