- March 29. Jane Fonda speaks on the anti-war movement and the Peoples' Peace Treaty in Dinkelspiel Aud. at 8 P.M.
- April 3. P.O.W. Day in Palo Alto. It is not known what events are being planned. Watch for further information.
- April 5. Dr. Joshua Horn, British Surgeon, who spent from 1954-1969 in China will speak Monday April 5 at 4:00 P.M. in the Tressider Lounge. Dr. Horn will talk about medicine in China and the Cultural Revolution.
- April 8. David Packard, Assistant Secretary of Defense speaks to Executives of Electronics Corporations at Picky's Hyatt House in Palo Alto. Demonstration starts at 5:30 P.M.
- April 9. Good Friday rally at Food Machinery Corporation, FMC, in San Jose, at noon. Sponsored by The Midpeninsula Peace Coalition.
- April 9. Benefit dance at the All Saints Episcopal Church in Palo Alto. Held by the Peoples' Peace Treaty Office and Palo Altans Against the War.
- April 10. "Anti-War Fair" in Lytton Plaza in Palo Alto, held by Palo Altans Against the War. Anti-imperialist games and music.
- April 11. San Francisco Mime Troupe will perform Women's Liberation and other plays in Dinkelspiel Aud. at 8 P.M., sponsored by the Stanford Women's Committee to Defend the Right to Live.
- Third week of April. China Week at Stanford, sponsored by the Committee of Concerned Asian Scholars.
- April 19-23. Shut-down actions against Food Machinery Corporation, FMC, in San Jose which is a major war corporation. FMC makes the "beehive" anti-personnel bomb, M113 Armored Personnel Carrier and firing systems for naval guns, all of which are used in Vietnam.
- April 24. Mass anti-war march in San Francisco (in conjunction with march in Washington, D.C.)
- May 1. Political Prisoners Support Rally in Dolores Park in San Francisco.
- May 3-4. Local actions focusing on military and war-related institutions in the Palo Alto area. These actions will be part of the Peoples' Spring Offensive against the war. Groups all across the country will be holding actions during the first week of May against the war. The major focal points for action, however, will be San Francisco and Washington, D.C..
- May 5. Mass Bay Area regional action against a major war-related target.
- May 11. Elections in Palo Alto. Anti-war referendum and several anti-imperialist candidates running for the City Council.
- May 16. Actions in Solidarity with GI's.
