There is a continuing conflict between the Forces of Good and the Forces of Evil. Most if history, in fact, is the story of this conflict. Progress—the collective betterment of the human condition—cannot be made until the concentrated power and wealth of the Forces of Evil are decimated or distributed. We call for the unified struggle, on all levels, of all Forces of Good against the Forces of Evil, leading to the development of a Good Society.

Human labor and natural resources are the sources of all wealth.

Today the Forces of Evil "own" or control a vastly disproportionate

share of this wealth. The collective fruit of our labor and benefits

of our environment belong to all people and should be used collectively

or be distributed according to need. This condition must be met to eliminate

poverty and other human want, and is an ecessary --but not sufficient-
step in the distribution of power.

One of the greatest victories of the Forces of Evil has been the prostitution of our culture to the authoritarian, competitive, wastemaking profit system. A Good Society must be based upon live and cooperation, democratic trust, and non-alienating labor. The culture—its varies media—must be accessible to all.

Not all problem of the Evil Society can be described merely in temms of the concentration of power and wealth and the accompanying cultural decadence. Many people face oppression due to their race (non-while), sex (female), colonization (people of Third World nations), and in some cases, age (very old and very young). These problems cannot be solved in isolation, but they require special solutions determined by the groups involved. A Good Society must allo, such special arrangements.

Throughout the development of the Good Movement the Forces of Good and project—
must develop—within the constraints imposed by the Evil Society and the repressive acts of the Forces of Evil—the style and values of the Good Society.
