

KY IS COMING !!

Tuesday, December 1, Vice-President Ky of South Vietnam is coming to San Francisco to address the Commonwealth Club.

Nguyen Cao Ky, "The Cowboy," symbolizes what America is fighting for in Southeast Asia. Even a man who says he idolizes-- and emulates--Adolph Hitler receives American support because he, in return, supports American interests.

Nixon and Ky both laud "Vietnamization," but the elite that Ky represents cannot, even with vast U.S. aid, defeat the National Liberation Front. The victory that the U.S. and its servants (Thieu, Ky, and Kiem, for now) seek means the destruction, through intense aerial and artillery bombardment and defoliation, of South Vietnam and perhaps the rest of Southeast Asia.

Ky's visit to San Francisco gives us an opportunity to protest U.S. policy in Vietnam, as well as the personal record of Nguyen Cao Ky. We should be careful to understand, however, that the U.S. may replace Ky and Thieu (remember Diem, Khanh, and Huong) as soon as he loses his value to the U.S. Rumors indicate that this may be our last chance to get to Ky before the CIA does.
