

WHO'S FREEDOM ?

The Hoover Institute was created by Herbert Hoover with one goal in mind. ("The purpose of this Institution," he said, "must be, by its research and publications, to demonstrate the evils of the doctrines of Karl Marx--whether Communism, Socialism, economic materialism, or atheism--thus to protect the American way of life from such ideologies, their conspiracies, and to reaffirm the validity of the American system.") The current director of the Institute, Glenn Campbell, is appropriate for this role. When asked about his reaction to Hoover's policy, he responded, "I see nothing wrong with it. Do you?"

Who sponsors Hoover? In recent years the Institute's board of advisors has included top executives from Standard Oil, Gulf Oil, Mobil Oil, Union Carbide, Cyanamid, U.S. Steel, Republic Steel, and Lockheed Aircraft. Why are these corporations so interested in Hoover? Perhaps because of the work they do in the memory of Herbert Hoover at the Institute. Campbell, a strong advocate of arms development, has stated, "The most promising way to prevent war is for the free nations to be so strong as to deter any potential aggressors." Hoover also produces an annual Yearbook on International Communist Affairs. Stefan Possony, director of the International Political Studies program at Hoover, is the strategy and military affairs editor for Washington Report, and an industry financed newsletter on national security problems. He supports the "preventive strike" strategy--a nuclear attack on Russia before they attack us.

All this literature--in the name of academic freedom--helps cause the deaths of thousands abroad each year. What does this mean for us here? In the words of Campbell, an important first step toward assuring the primacy of national security is to stop the further expansion of federal expenditures for domestic benefits.--deaths for thousands here too who can't get jobs or welfare or medical care.

And this is our community. Stanford contributes \$334,000 a year to the Institute's operation.
