CRIMES AGAINST

HUMANITY

WHEREAS, FMC by the manufacture of the M113 Armored Personnel Carrier, the LTV P7 Amphibious Vehicle, the CBU-41 Firebomb and "Beehive" Anti-Personnel weapons, all for use in Vietnam, is guilty of War Crimes against the VIETNAMESE PEOPLE.

WHEREAS, FMC by the manufacture of highly poisonous pesticides, 5 of which (DDT, Aldrin, Dieldrin, Endrin and Thiodan) have been banned by the United Farmworkers Organizing Committee, is guilty of Crimes against the American People, especially FARMWORKERS.

WHEREAS, FMC by the manufacture of 8 phosphate products used in soaps and detergents which are a prime cause of the destruction of our lakes, streams and rivers is guilty of Crimes against the ENVIRONMENT.

We hereby charge the FMC Board of Directors who are ultimately responsible for the above policies, with Crimes against Humanity. We intend to present these charges at FMC's annual Stockholders Meeting on April 30. In addition, we will place the following demands:

1. WE DEMAND THAT FMC STOP ALL WAR PRODUCTION.
2. WE DEMAND THAT FMC STOP THE PRODUCTION OF PESTICIDES BANNED BY UFWOC.
3. WE DEMAND THAT FMC STOP THE PRODUCTION OF PHOSPHATES FOR USE IN SOAPS AND DETERGENTS.
4. WE DEMAND THAT FMC CONVERT TO THE PRODUCTION OF PEACE-TIME GOODS AND THAT DURING THIS CONVERSION ALL WORKERS JOBS BE PRESERVED.
5. WE DEMAND THAT FMC ANSWER THESE CHARGES IN A PUBLICIZED DEBATE ON PRIME TIME TV, PAID FOR BY FMC.
