DAVID PACKARD--"the Pentagon's No. 2 man"--started making profits off death during World War II, when he first sold electronic equipment to the military. As President of Hewlett-Packard, he amassed a personal fortune of over \$300 million. This helped him become a Stanford trustee in 1954. Soon he was a member of the advisory committee of Stanford's anti-communist propaganda agency, the Hoover Institute, a Vice President of the Stanford Research Institute, and a member of the advisory board of the Chase Manhattan Bank. He was a major force in the prostitution of University brains to the military-industrial complex on the Mid-peninsula. THIS THURSDAY DAVID PACKARD RETURNS TO PALO ALTO AS DEPUTY SECRETARY OF DEFENSE AND THIS AREA'S MOST HEINOUS WAR CRIMINAL.

PACKARD SPEAKS FOR HIMSELF:

ON GENOCIDE

"The President has acted rightly and in the national interest.... We are presently engaged in a military effort to bring about peace in Southeast Asia.... [We] fully support the President's policy of doing no more and no less than what is necessary militarily in Vietnam."

ON STANFORD AND THE WAR

"Hundreds of millions of dollars come into...California every year through your great aircraft and electronics companies to manufacture [war] devices totally dependent on laboratories at Stanford."

ON GREED

"Profit is the proper measure of the contribution we make to society."

ON ELITISM

"Industry also contributes to the community when it attracts new citizens to the area who are compatible with the citizens already there--or who are, perhaps, hopefully better."

ON OVERDEVELOPMENT

"The Board of Trustees has studied ...the traffic problems and the probable effect of the future freeway to the foothills.... A further extension of the Stanford Industrial Park...will be of the greatest benefit to Stanford and the community as a whole."

ON THE ANTI-WAR MOVEMENT

"Stanford...is infiltrated by a hard core that will have to be eliminated. ... Tension in this country will have to come to a head some day, and it might as well be now."
