

# Vietnamese Election Vigil

A Wake for Democracy

Join us in a Twenty-four hour farewell to democratic pretense in South Vietnam on the eve of the "re-election" of Nguyen Van Thieu, the only candidate for president of the Saigon regime.

We protest this mockery of an election.  
We protest our government's refusal to withdraw support for Thieu.  
We support the Seven Point Peace Proposal made in Paris by the Vietnamese as the only serious basis for a negotiated settlement. It provides a basis for 1) cessation of the bombing, 2) release of U.S. POW's on a timetable commensurate with a set date for withdrawal of U.S. troops, 3) strict observation of a cease fire and 4) withdrawal of U.S. support for the illegitimate regime of Nguyen Van Thieu.
