RE: COUNTERINTELLIGENCE AND SPECIAL OPERATIONS

Mr. James Durnham:

Your thesis "The Protracted Conflict" (NR 11/17/70) largely rationalizes a people's electoral mandate in Chile as Marxist-Leninist protracted warfare. The victory of the proletariat in Chile is an example of the natural evolution of Third World forces to socialism, a political phenomena which will continue and progress in the emerging nations and those, like Chile, where the reactionary designs of U.S. imperialism are isolated and exposed to the masses. Marxist-Leninist-Maoist interpretation of the Chilean war is linked to the class of world imperialism necessitates armed revolutionary struggle. Your "revisionist" interpretation is indicative of the philo-technical-generation gap which paved the revolutionary road for the progressive masses of the world.
